Note on screenshots:

- The CAPTURCYL mobile app interface is currently available in Spanish. Screenshots therefore show the original Spanish interface. Button, tab and field names are given in this manual in English, followed by the on-screen Spanish label in italics and brackets, e.g. **CREATE NEW ACCOUNT** (*CREAR NUEVA CUENTA*). A complete Spanish–English interface glossary is provided at the end of this manual, consistent with the terminology of the web application manual.

1. Control system workflow

The telematic capture control system consists of two access channels:

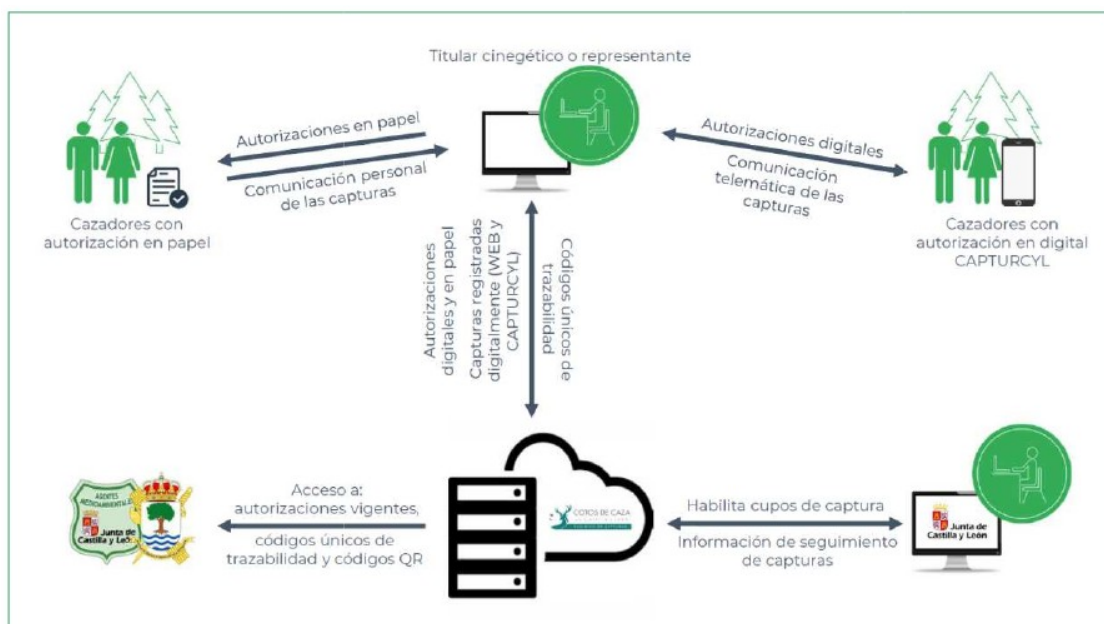
- A web application for hunting rights holders, accessible at the URL: <https://capturascotos.cazacyl.es>
- An application for hunters and for organizers of montería and gancho driven hunts, called CAPTURCYL, available for Android (Google Play Store) and iOS (Apple Store) mobile devices.

The telematic control of the hunting preserve's captures is carried out by the hunting rights holder or their representative from the web application. The data entered is stored in a single database through which the information, properly segmented, reaches the different users linked to and selected for each of the authorizations issued.

The hunting rights holder must issue the different authorizations through this web application. Depending on the case, they may be exclusively digital, or either digital or on paper.

Once the information is linked to the hunters or to the organizers of monterías and ganchos through the authorizations, they can:

- With a digital authorization: access the mobile app, sign it and record their captures, which are stored in the hunting preserve's database.
- With a paper authorization: sign it and fill in a series of fields on it, reporting the capture to the hunting rights holder, who must then record it through the web application for hunting rights holders.

2. Registration and access to CAPTURCYL

The CAPTURCYL mobile app (hereinafter CAPTURCYL) is intended for hunters and for organizers of montería and gancho driven hunts (hereinafter, organizers).

To use CAPTURCYL for the first time, the hunter or organizer must download the application from the app store and install it on their mobile device.

The minimum technical requirements for using the CAPTURCYL app are that the smartphone has a camera and that the operating system is updated to at least the following version:

- On Android, minimum version 5.0
- On iOS, minimum version 13.0

CAPTURCYL is interconnected with the web application intended for hunting rights holders. Once the app is installed, and before creating a new account, the hunter or organizer must first have been added by the hunting rights holder to the hunter list of the hunting preserve where they intend to hunt.

The hunter or organizer using CAPTURCYL should therefore bear in mind that it is the hunting rights holder (the web application user) who is responsible for initially entering their details as a hunter or organizer in the control system.

2.1. How to create a new account

Once CAPTURCYL is downloaded, the hunter or organizer must use **CREATE NEW ACCOUNT** (CREAR NUEVA CUENTA)¹ to register on the platform.

The first step after selecting **CREATE NEW ACCOUNT**¹ is to enter the hunter's or organizer's DNI (8 digits plus a letter)².

To create the new account, it is mandatory to accept the app's terms of use and legal notice, which can be consulted by tapping (**see terms**) (*ver condiciones*)³; they are displayed on a new screen for the hunter to read and review.

Once the terms are accepted⁴, tap the **Validate DNI** (*Validar DNI*) button⁵, and the application will check whether that DNI has been registered as a hunter or organizer in any hunting preserve.

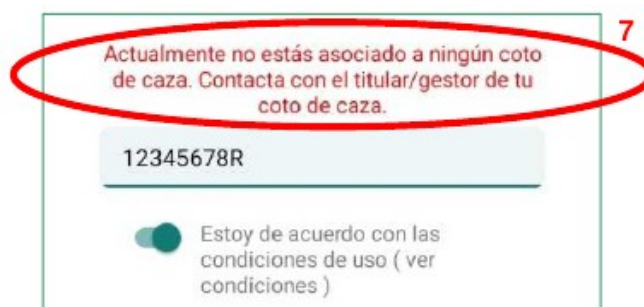
If the option to create a new hunter or organizer account was opened by mistake, it is possible to return to the previous step by tapping the **Back to home** (*Volver a inicio*) button⁶.



Callouts 2 to 6: DNI field, terms of use and legal notice, acceptance toggle, Validate DNI and Back to home.

Important notices:

- Where the hunter or organizer using CAPTURCYL is also registered as a user of the web application intended for hunting rights holders, that is, with the same DNI, they must use the same password in both applications.
- Where the hunter or organizer is not linked to any hunting preserve, upon **Validate DNI**⁵ a message will appear reading: **You are currently not linked to any hunting preserve. Contact the holder/manager of your hunting preserve** (Actualmente no estás asociado a ningún coto de caza. Contacta con el titular/gestor de tu coto de caza)⁷.

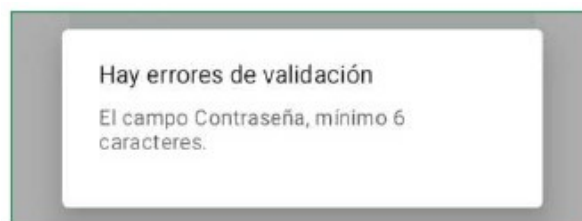


Callout 7: message shown when the DNI is not linked to any preserve.

Once the DNI is validated successfully, the next step to create the hunter's or organizer's new account is to complete the following fields⁸:

Callout 8: registration fields.

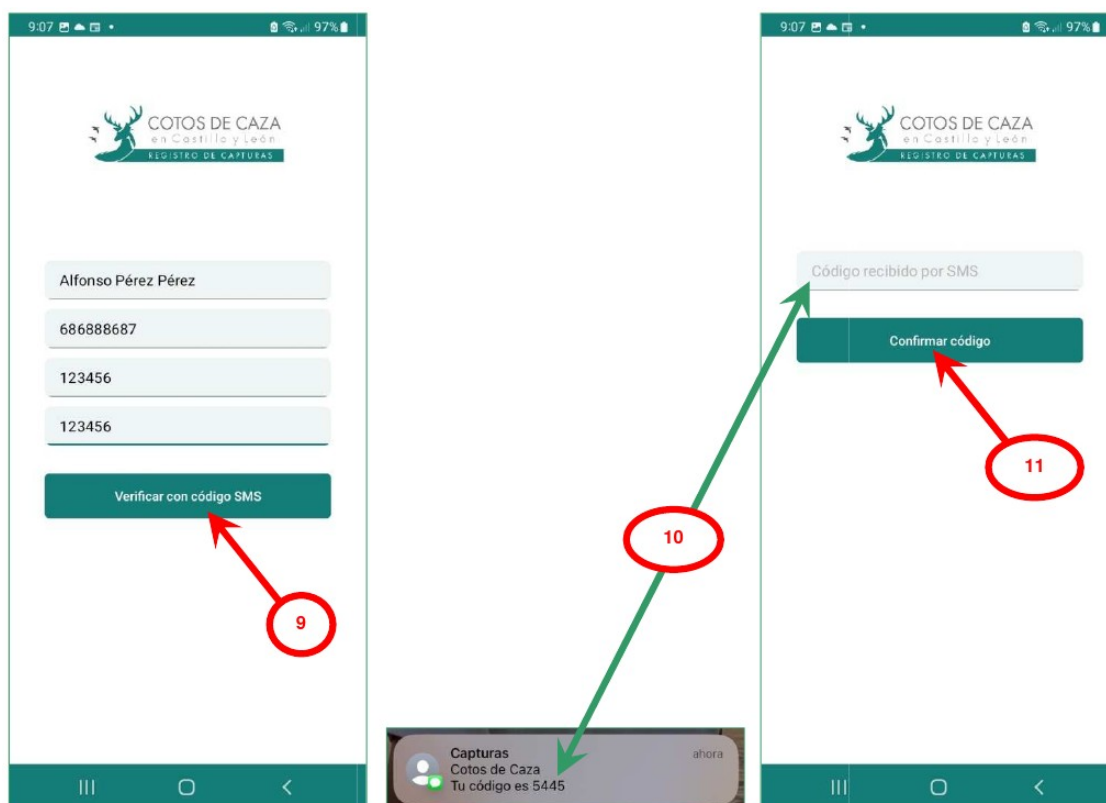
- **Enter your name and surname** (*Indique su nombre y apellidos*): this field is completed with the hunter's or organizer's details.
- **Telephone** (*Teléfono*): the hunter's or organizer's telephone number, or the number where the SMS code will be received.
- **Password** (*Contraseña*): this field must contain at least 6 characters. If the chosen password has fewer characters, the following message will appear:



Validation error: the Password field requires a minimum of 6 characters.

- **Repeat password** (*Repetir contraseña*): this field must match the previous one.

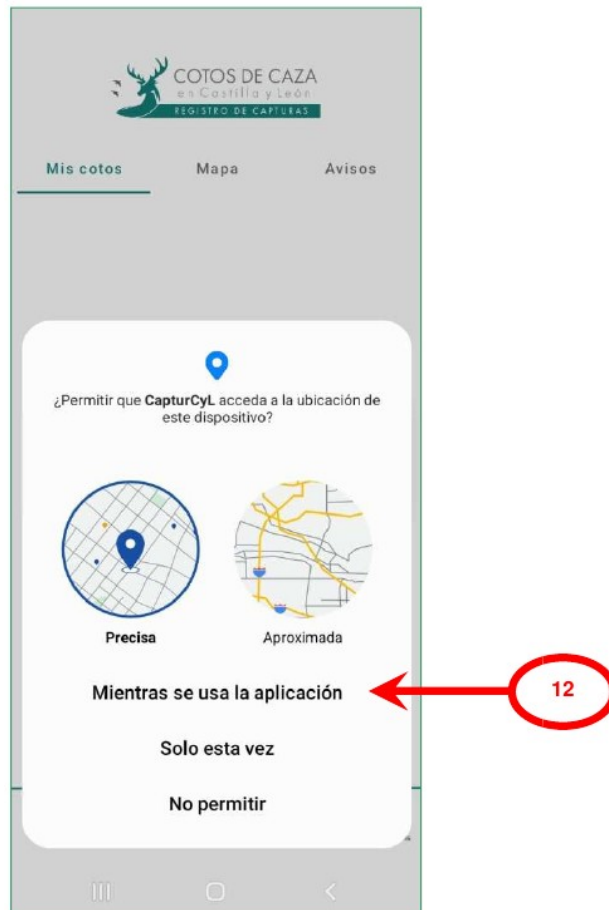
Once the fields are completed, the user must tap the **Verify with SMS code** (*Verificar con código SMS*) button⁹. A new screen opens and a four-digit account verification code is received by SMS at the telephone number provided¹⁰. On the new screen, enter the code and then tap the **Confirm code** (*Confirmar código*) button¹¹.

From this moment on, once the account has been created, the hunter or organizer can access CAPTURCYL with their DNI (8 digits plus a letter) and the chosen password.

When CAPTURCYL is installed for the first time, the application requests permission to access the device's location; it is recommended to select the option **While using the app** (*Mientras se usa la aplicación*)¹². As explained later in this manual, the application only records the hunter's or organizer's location at the moment a capture is recorded.

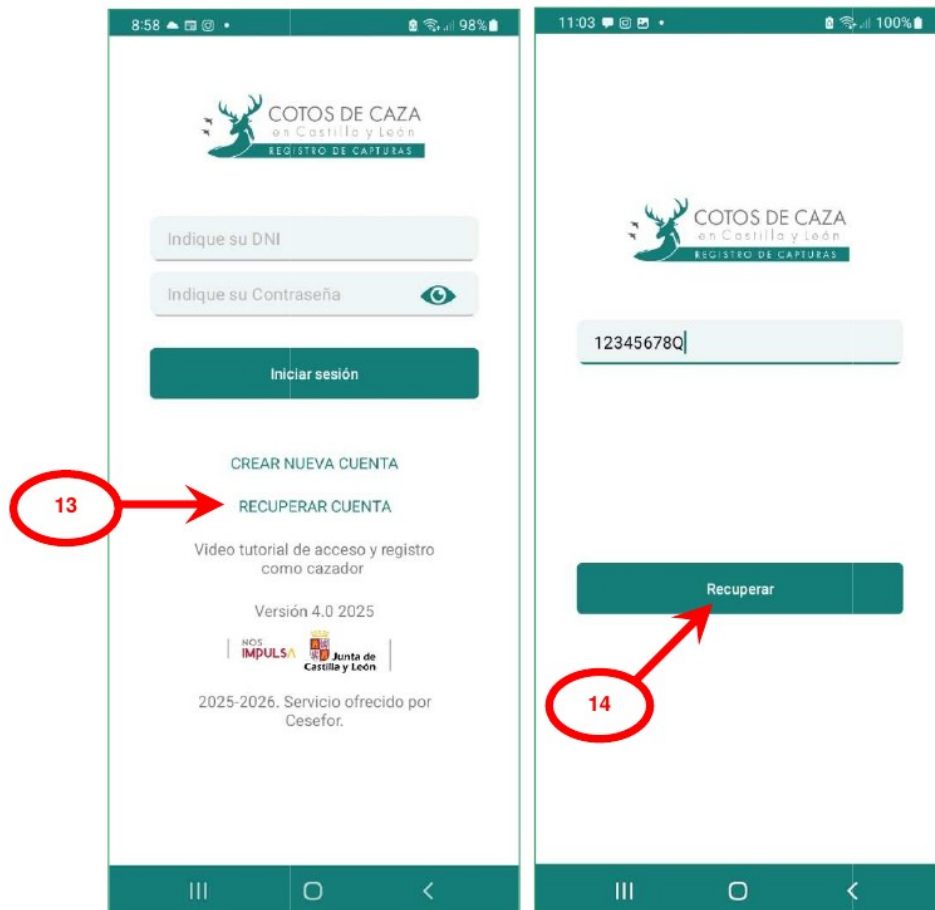


Location permission request. Callout 12: "While using the app" option.

The account can be accessed from any mobile device the user works with, as long as the application is installed on it.

2.2. How to recover an account when the password is lost

Where the hunter or organizer has forgotten their account password, a new password can be set by tapping the **RECOVER ACCOUNT** (*RECUPERAR CUENTA*) button¹³. On the next screen, enter the DNI and tap the **Recover** (*Recuperar*) button¹⁴; an SMS is then sent to the telephone number provided when the account was first created.

Important notice:

- Where, for whatever reason, the hunter or organizer no longer has the telephone number linked to the account, they must contact technical support at the e-mail address: sopORTE@capturascotos.app

Once the SMS with a four-digit code is received, a series of fields must be completed¹⁵:

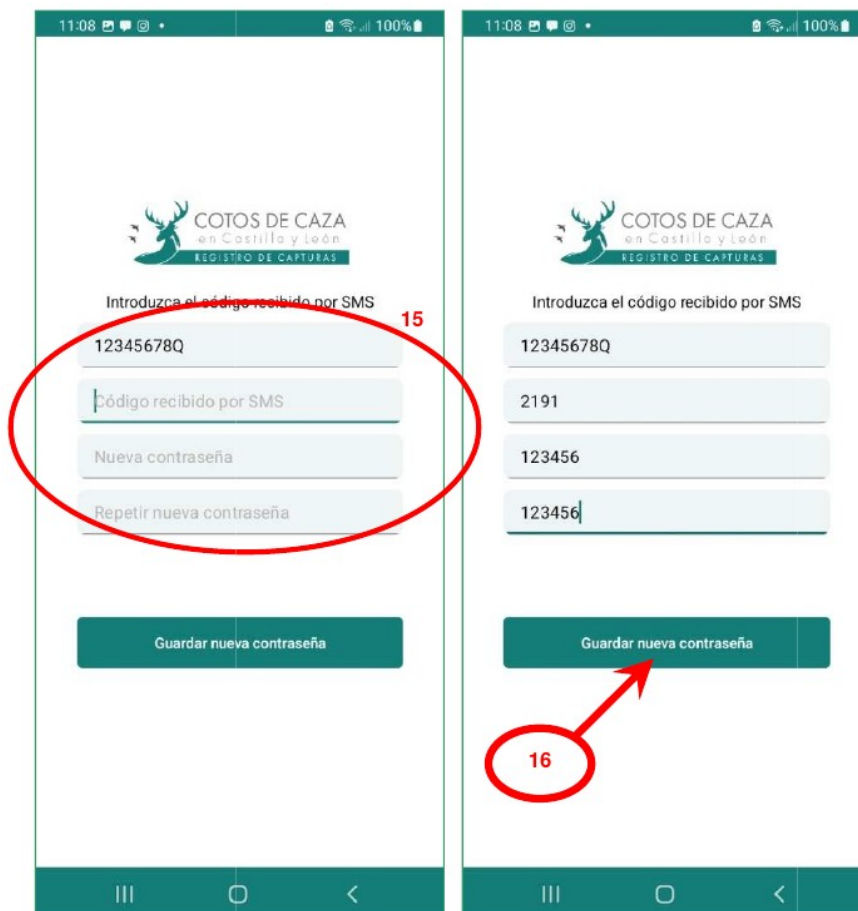
- **Code received by SMS** (*Código recibido por SMS*): this field is completed with the four-digit number received by SMS at the telephone number provided when the account was first created.

- **New password** (*Nueva contraseña*): this field must contain at least 6 characters.
- **Repeat new password** (*Repetir nueva contraseña*): this field must match the previous one.

Finally, once all fields are completed and the **Save new password** (*Guardar nueva contraseña*) button ¹⁶ is tapped, the hunter or organizer can use their CAPTURCYL account again.

3. CAPTURCYL general menu

The general menu displayed at the bottom of the device screen consists of five tabs:

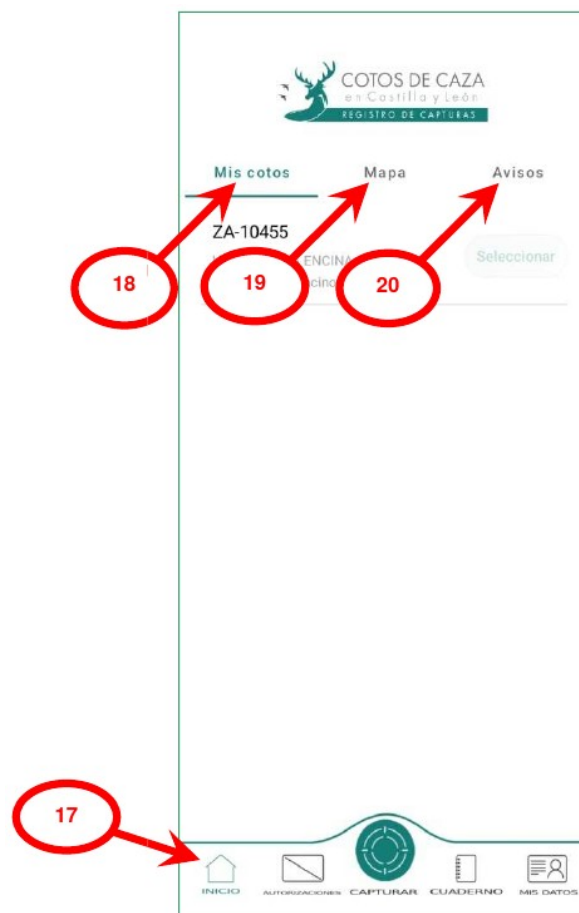
- ✓ **HOME** (INICIO)
- ✓ **AUTHORIZATIONS** (AUTORIZACIONES)
- ✓ **CAPTURE** (CAPTURAR)
- ✓ **LOGBOOK** (CUADERNO)
- ✓ **MY DETAILS** (MIS DATOS)

3.1 HOME tab (INICIO)

The **HOME** tab¹⁷ is the default screen shown when the app is opened. This screen contains three sub-tabs: **My preserves** (Mis cotos)¹⁸, **Map** (Mapa)¹⁹ and **Notices** (Avisos)²⁰.



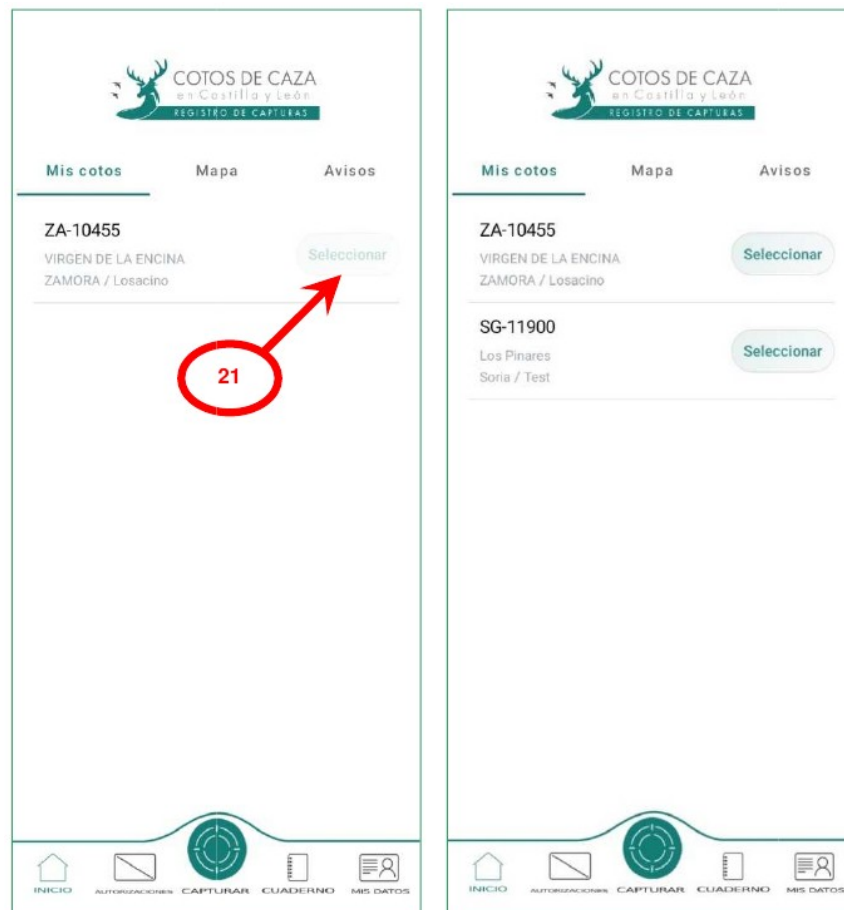
Callout 17: HOME tab. Callouts 18 to 20: My preserves, Map and Notices sub-tabs.

3.1.1 My preserves sub-tab (Mis cotos)

This sub-tab lists all the hunting preserves in which the hunter or organizer has been registered as such. With the **Select** (Seleccionar) button²¹, the hunter or organizer can access the information linking them to that preserve, which enables the remaining functionalities associated with it.

Important notice:

- Where the hunter or organizer knows they have been added to a new hunting preserve but that preserve does not appear in the preserve list, it is recommended to restart the session (see section 3.5, MY DETAILS tab, of this manual).

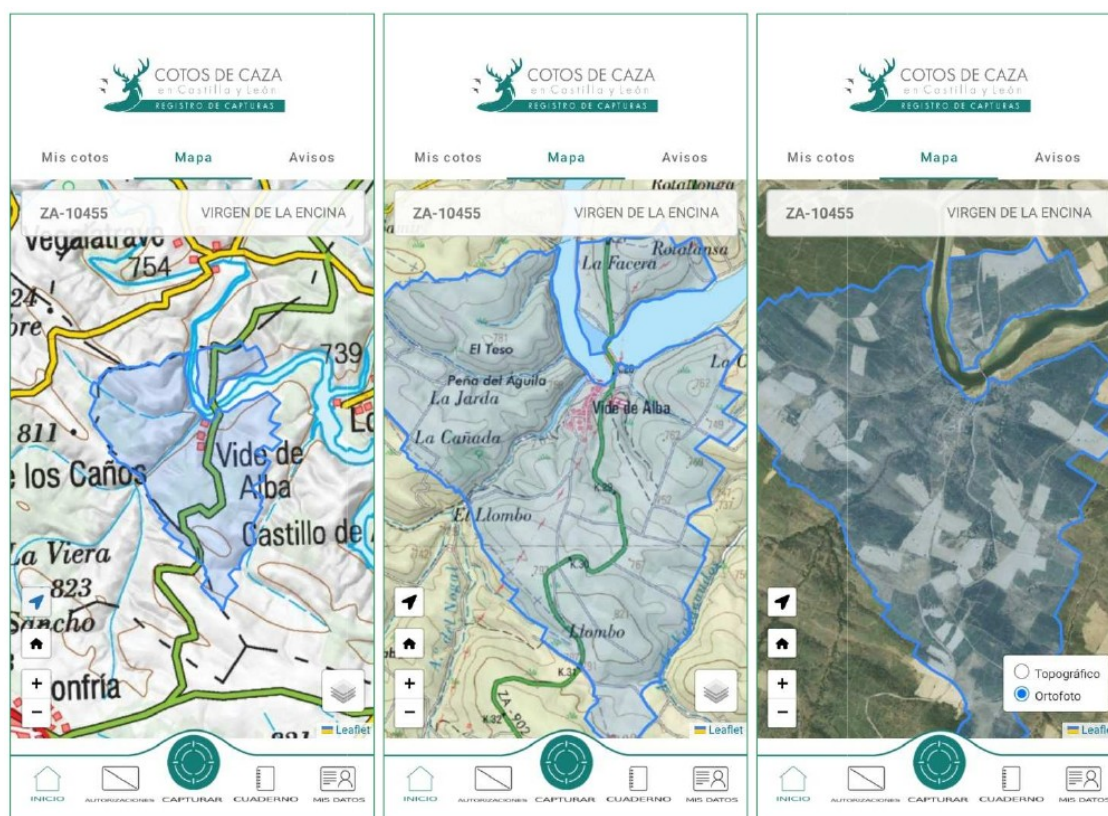

3.1.2 Map sub-tab (Mapa)

Once a hunting preserve is selected, this sub-tab gives the hunter or organizer access to a map viewer showing the boundaries of the preserve, with the option to display topographic layers or orthophotos.

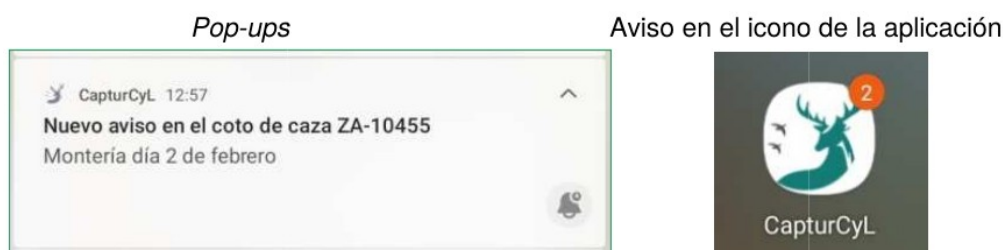
This option is useful when the hunter or organizer wants to know the exact boundaries of the hunting preserve, and even their own position relative to them. The hunting preserve layer shown by the application is the one defined as *Caza CyL: terrenos cinegéticos* (hunting grounds), freely downloadable through the Spatial Data Infrastructure of Castilla y León (IDECyL).

3.1.3 Notices sub-tab (Avisos)

This sub-tab allows the hunter or organizer to receive notifications generated through the web application, both by the hunting rights holder of the preserve and by the application administrator. These notices also appear as pop-ups in the mobile device's notification panel, warning of their arrival, and on the app icon, indicating unread notices.

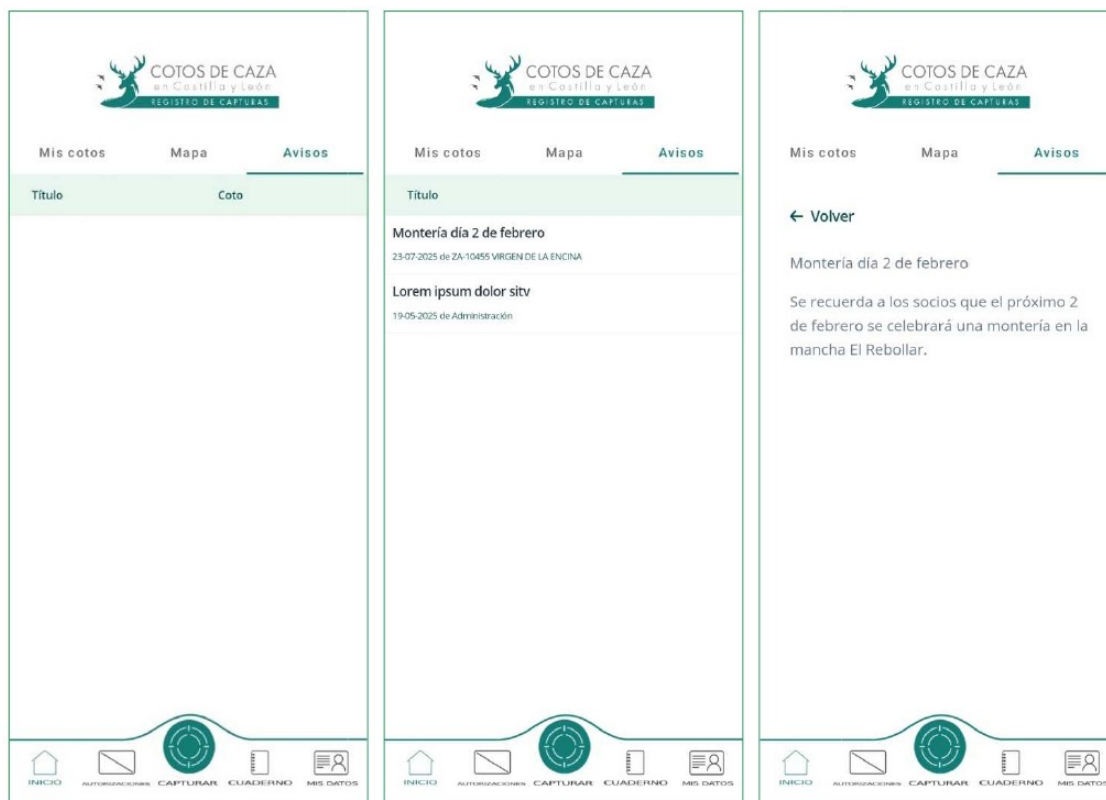
Notices generated by the hunting rights holder may contain any circumstance they consider worth communicating to the hunters or organizers using CAPTURCYL.

Notices generated by the application administrator may be of several types, most notably:

- **Generic notices:** a notification arising from any change in hunting conditions, the population status of a species, the appearance of a disease, etc. In these cases, the application sends a notice to the hunter's or organizer's notice inbox, informing them of any supervening circumstance.
- **Notices for exceeding the alert coefficient:** when the captures of a game species with a quota and without a pre-assigned unique traceability code reach a set percentage of that quota, the

system automatically sends a notice to the hunter's or organizer's notice inbox, informing them that the set percentage has been reached or exceeded.

- Notices for reaching the quota set for a species: when the captures of a game species with a quota and without a pre-assigned unique traceability code reach the quota set for the hunting preserve, the system automatically sends a notice to the hunter's or organizer's notice inbox, informing them that this quota has been reached.

3.2 AUTHORIZATIONS tab (AUTORIZACIONES)

The **AUTHORIZATIONS** tab²² gathers all the authorizations issued by the holder of the hunting preserve. This screen contains two sub-tabs: **Active** (Vigentes)²³ and **History** (Histórico)²⁴.

The tab has a filter ²⁵ that allows all authorizations to be displayed, or only the authorizations for a given hunting preserve.

3.2.1 Active sub-tab (Vigentes)

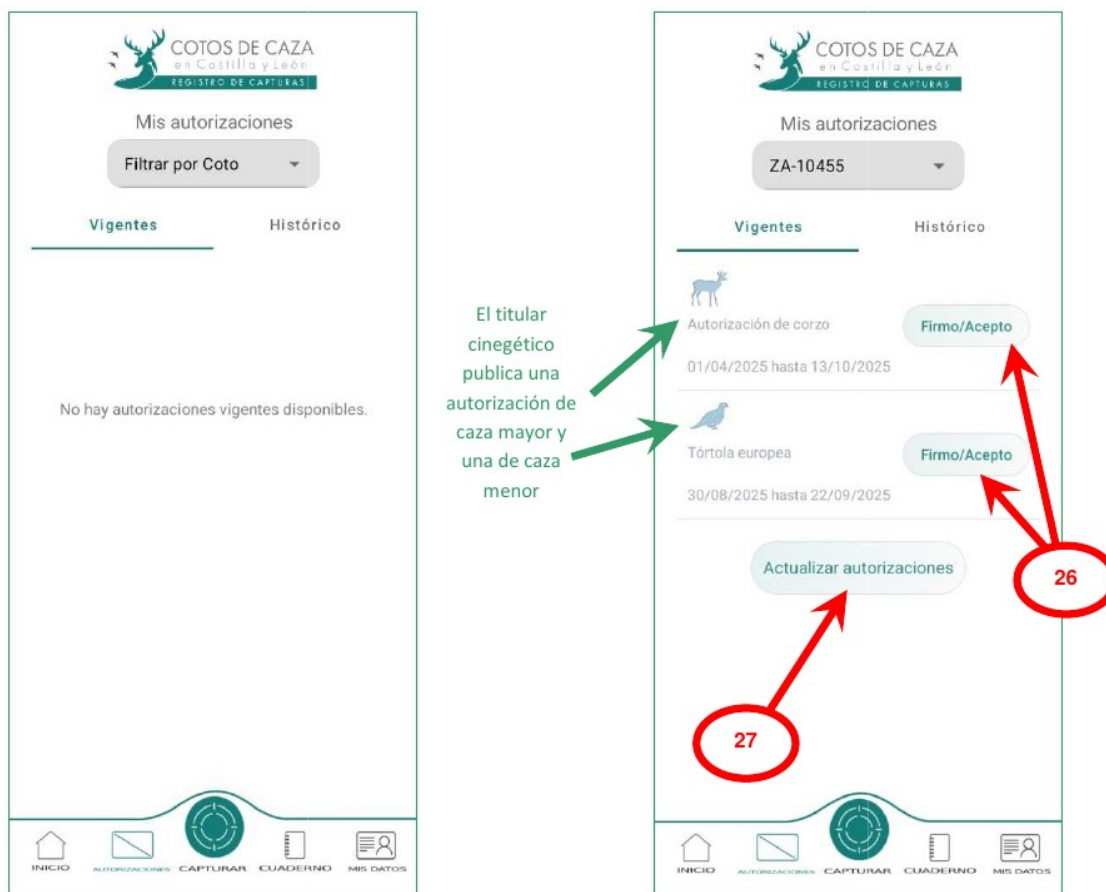
As its name suggests, the **Active** sub-tab shows all authorizations currently in force.

When the hunting rights holder issues an authorization in favor of a hunter or organizer, it is added automatically to the CAPTURCYL app.

Important notice:

- The mobile device hosting the CAPTURCYL app must have internet coverage in order to automatically download any type of authorization issued in favor of the hunter or organizer.

In compliance with Article 12.4 of Law 4/2021, of 1 July, on Hunting and Sustainable Management of Hunting Resources, in order to use any authorization issued by the hunting rights holder, the hunter or organizer must sign it by tapping the **I sign/I accept** (*Firmo/Acepto*) button ²⁶.



The holder publishes a big game and a small game authorization; both appear with the I sign/I accept button (callout 26).
Callout 27: Refresh authorizations.

Important notice:

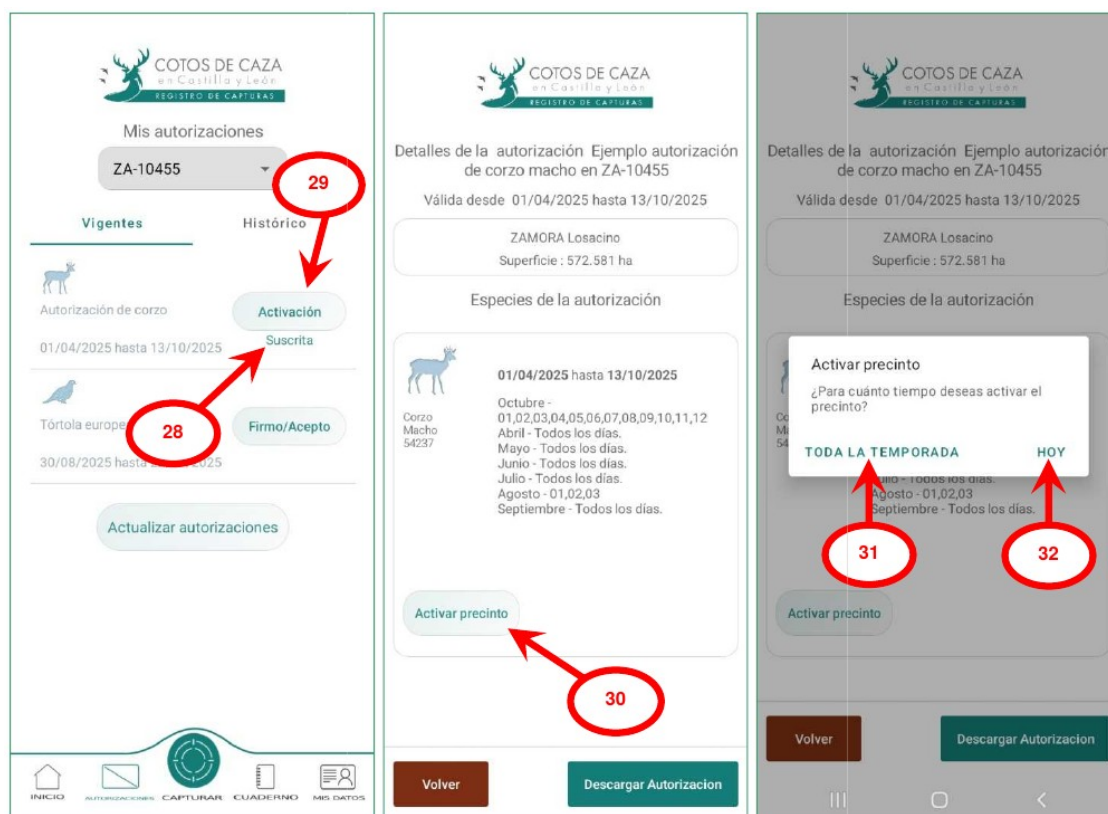
- The **Refresh authorizations** (*Actualizar autorizaciones*) button ²⁷ performs a manual refresh of the hunter's or organizer's authorizations.

Authorizations for red deer, roe deer, Iberian ibex, chamois, fallow deer and mouflon (**INTENDED ONLY FOR THE HUNTER USER**):

These species have a unique traceability code (tag) pre-assigned in accordance with the approved hunting plan. In addition to necessarily signing the authorization first ²⁸, the hunter must activate the tag.

The tag activation process is summarized in three steps:

1. Tap the **Activation** (*Activación*) button ²⁹.
2. On the next screen, tap the **Activate tag** (*Activar precinto*) button ³⁰.
3. Finally, choose the period during which the tag should remain active: **WHOLE SEASON** (*TODA LA TEMPORADA*) ³¹ or only **TODAY** (*HOY*) ³² (option valid until 11:59 p.m. of the activation day).

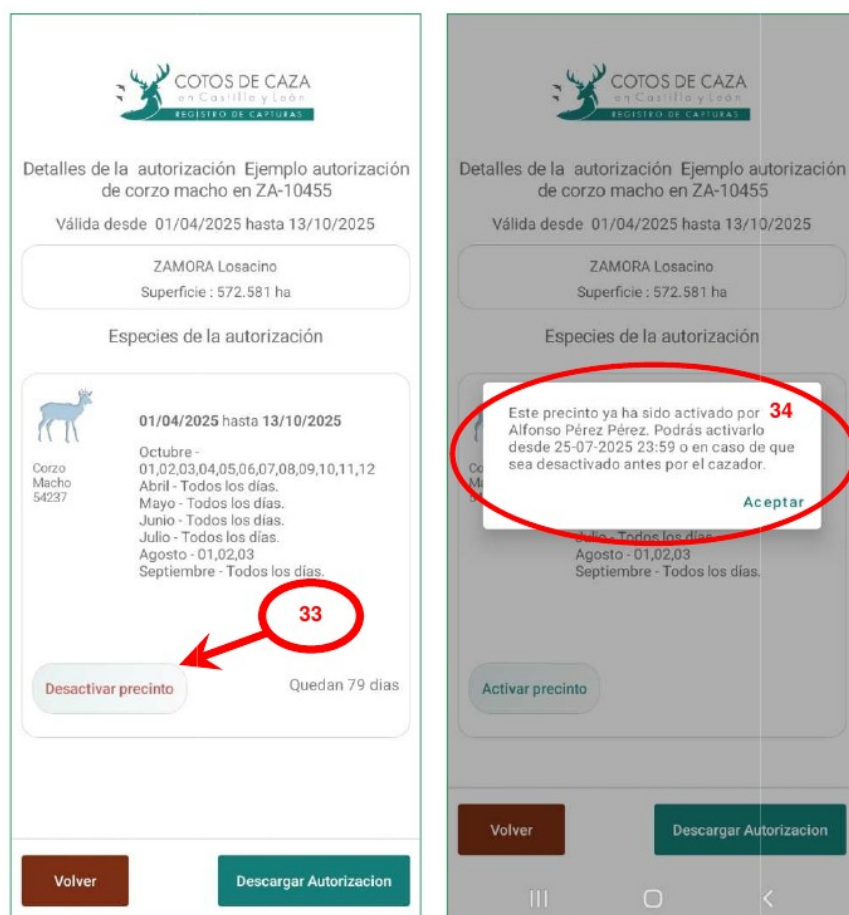


Callouts 28 to 32: signed authorization, Activation button, Activate tag, WHOLE SEASON and TODAY options.

Important notices:

- Activation does not mean the hunter will hunt immediately; the tag can be activated as soon as it is received in the hunter's CAPTURCYL account.
- The activation feature allows several hunters to share the same tag, with the restriction that only one hunter can have the tag activated at a time.
- Activating or deactivating a tag requires the device to have an internet connection at that moment. Activating a tag does not involve any geolocation of the mobile device.

CAPTURCYL allows the hunter who has a tag activated to deactivate it at any time through the **Deactivate tag** (*Desactivar precinto*) button³³. Furthermore, if a hunter tries to activate a shared tag that has already been activated by another hunter, a pop-up window appears at that moment indicating who has it activated³⁴.

Finally, from the activation/deactivation screen of the game species, the hunter has access to the issued authorization, previously signed through the **I sign/I accept** button, in digital format, and can download it through the **Download Authorization** (*Descargar Autorización*) button³⁵.

Callout 35: Download Authorization button and the resulting digital authorization document.

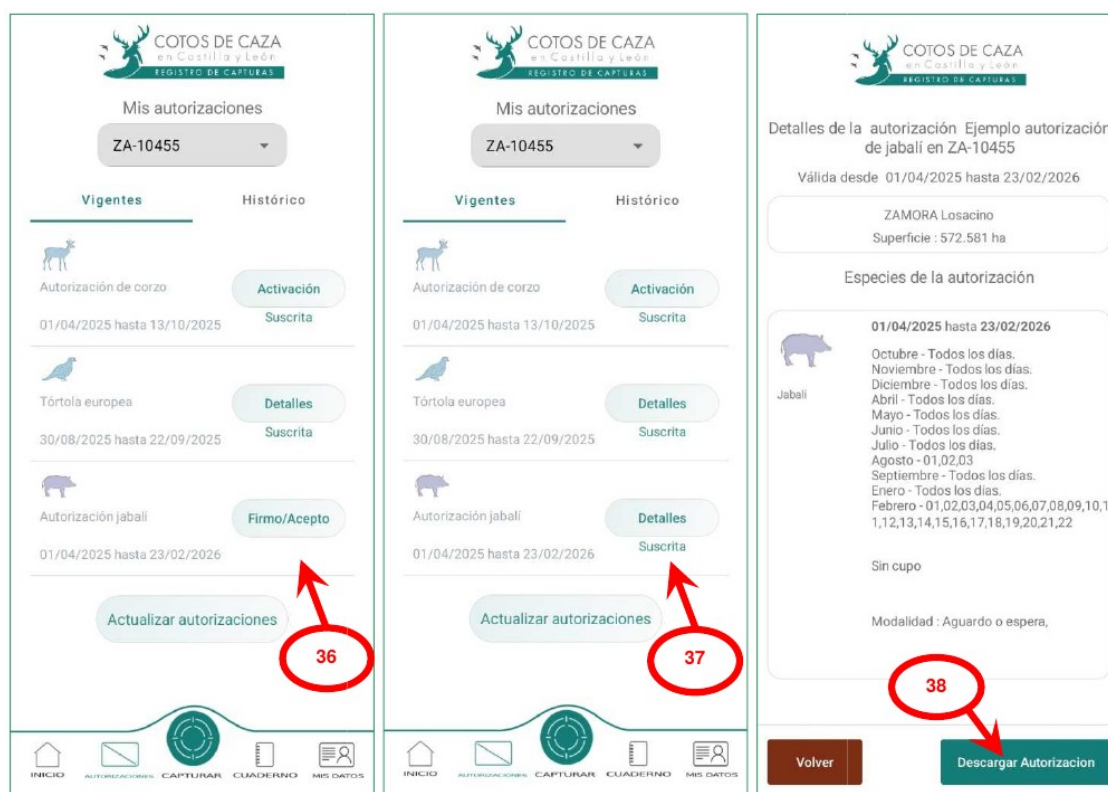
Important notices:

- For this type of authorization to be valid during the hunting action, it must be signed by the hunter through the **I sign/I accept** button and the tag must be activated.
- During the hunting action, the hunter using the CAPTURCYL app does not need to carry any paper authorization for these game species authorized for CAPTURCYL.

Authorizations for wild boar, excluding collective hunts (**INTENDED ONLY FOR THE HUNTER USER**):

This species does not have a unique traceability code (tag) pre-assigned in accordance with the approved hunting plan; the code is generated automatically when the capture is recorded.

Authorizations for this species only need to be signed through the **I sign/I accept** action³⁶. Once an authorization is signed, the information linked to it can be consulted through the **Details (Detalles)** button³⁷, and it can be obtained in digital format through the **Download Authorization** button³⁸.



Callouts 36 to 38: I sign/I accept, Details and Download Authorization for a wild boar authorization.

Important notices:

- For this type of authorization to be valid during the hunting action, it must be signed by the hunter through the **I sign/I accept** button.
- As in the previous case, during the hunting action the hunter using the CAPTURCYL app does not need to carry any paper authorization for the wild boar species, nor for any small game species that sectoral regulations may, where applicable, establish.

Authorizations for collective hunts (**INTENDED ONLY FOR THE ORGANIZER USER**):

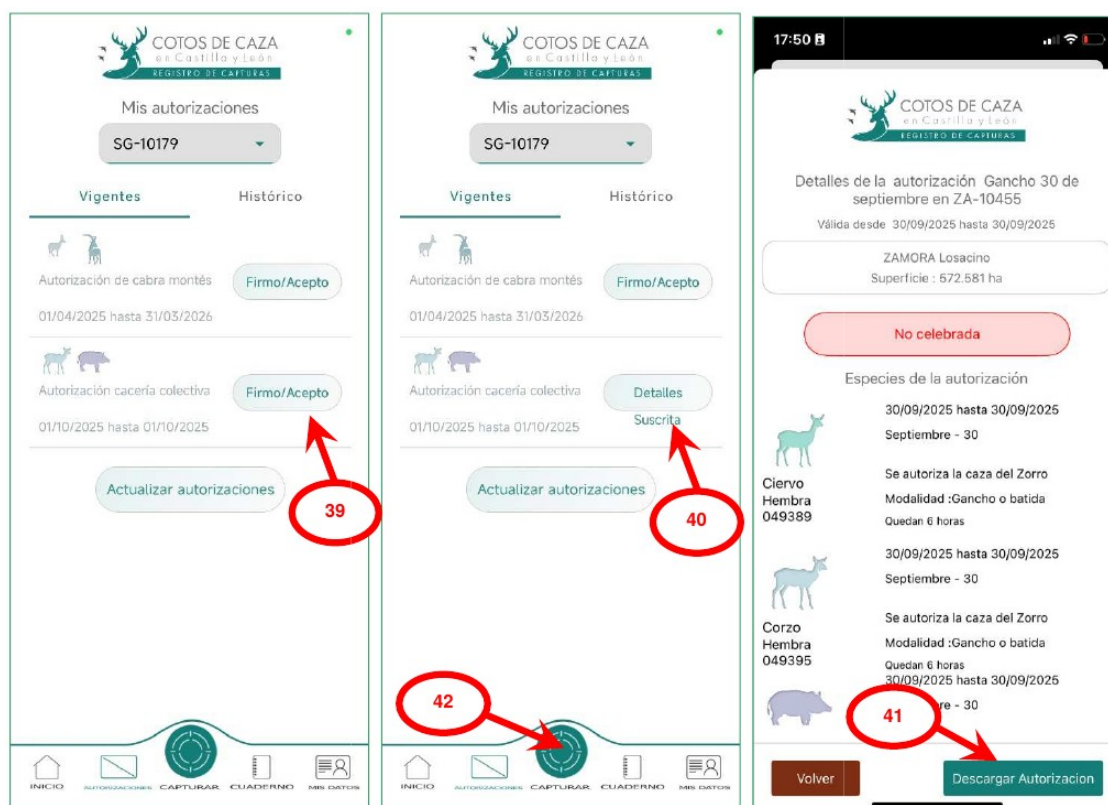
These authorizations, intended exclusively for organizers of montería and gancho driven hunts, may include species subject to a unique traceability code (tag) pre-assigned in accordance with the approved hunting plan, as well as the wild boar species, which has no pre-assigned codes.

The unique traceability codes assigned to this type of authorization appear activated automatically, for the day of the hunt, from the moment the authorization is created from the web.

Authorizations of this type only need to be signed through the **I sign/I accept** action³⁹. Once an authorization is signed, the information linked to it can be consulted through the **Details** button⁴⁰, and it can be obtained in digital format through the **Download Authorization** button⁴¹.

Likewise, captures can be reported through the central **CAPTURE (CAPTURAR)** button of the menu⁴² once the **I sign/I accept** button has been tapped.

At the end of the day, the authorization ends automatically, and the assigned unique traceability codes (tags) that were not used become available again for the hunting preserve.



Callouts 39 to 42: I sign/I accept, Details, Download Authorization and the central CAPTURE button for a collective hunt authorization.

Important notices:

- For this type of authorization to be valid during the hunting action, it must be signed by the organizer through the **I sign/I accept** button.
- The organizer does not need to activate the unique traceability codes.
- In this type of authorization, the hunters attending the hunt do not have to perform any action in or for the telematic capture control system.
- Where, for whatever reason, the hunt is not held, the organizer has a **Not held** (*No celebrada*) button⁴³ within the **Details** of the authorization, through which the non-holding of the collective hunt can be reported. Once the **Not held** button is tapped, the option must be confirmed⁴⁴, preventing accidental taps of the button.
- In this format, the organizer, the only user of the CAPTURCYL app, does not need to carry any paper authorization during the hunting action, as in the previous cases.

3.2.2 History sub-tab (Histórico)

This sub-tab automatically stores all authorizations that have been cancelled or whose validity has ended.

3.3 CAPTURE tab (CAPTURAR)

The **CAPTURE** tab⁴⁵ is only used by the hunter or organizer at the moment they need to record the capture of a game species under the conditions established by the regulations.



Callout 45: central CAPTURE button in the bottom menu.

Tapping this tab opens a new window that allows the user to:

- Choose the hunting preserve with the **Change** (*Cambiar*) button⁴⁶, for cases where the user holds authorizations in more than one hunting preserve.

- Choose the captured species with the **Select species** (*Seleccionar especie*) button ⁴⁷. This button allows the game species covered by a digital CAPTURCYL authorization to be chosen.



Callout 46: Change preserve. Callout 47: Select species drop-down.

Important notices:

- To be able to record captures, it is mandatory to have signed the authorization through the **I sign/I accept** button; otherwise, captures referring to an unsigned authorization cannot be recorded.
- In addition, for big game species with a unique traceability code (tag) pre-assigned in accordance with the approved hunting plan, it is mandatory to have the tag activated in order to record the capture (except for collective hunts, where activation is automatic).

Recording captures of red deer, roe deer, Iberian ibex, chamois, fallow deer and mouflon:

For species with a pre-assigned unique traceability code (tag), the capture information must be recorded:

- In authorizations for hunters under the stalking, stand or wait, walked-up and driven-in-line methods, the capture must be recorded without moving the animal or separating the trophy from the rest of the animal.
- In authorizations for organizers of collective hunts under the montería and gancho formats, the capture or captures must be recorded once the hunt is over, before moving the animals out of the preserve where they were captured or away from the game collection point.

The steps for recording captures are similar to those for the other big game species, with the following particularities:

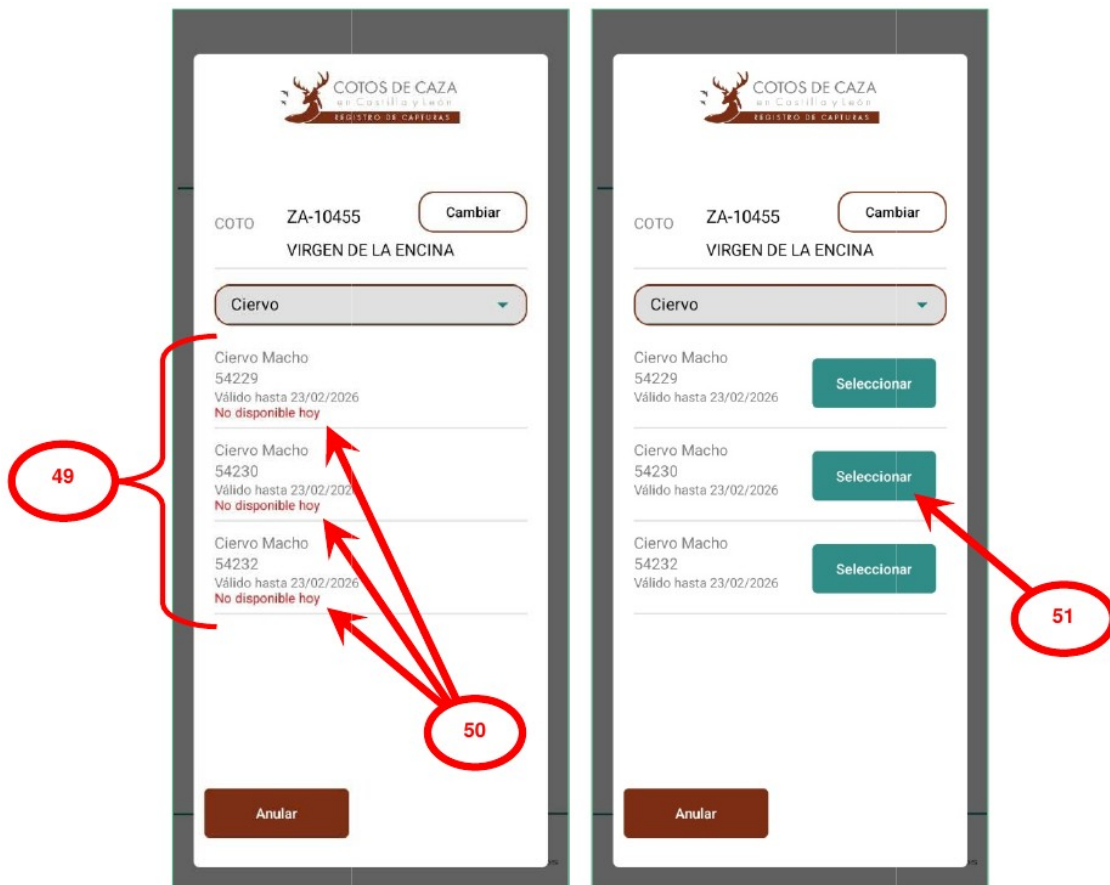
1. Tap the **CAPTURE** button ⁴⁵.

2. Using the **Change**⁴⁶ and **Select species**⁴⁷ buttons as explained above, select (where applicable) the hunting preserve where the capture or captures will be recorded, and the game species that was hunted⁴⁸.



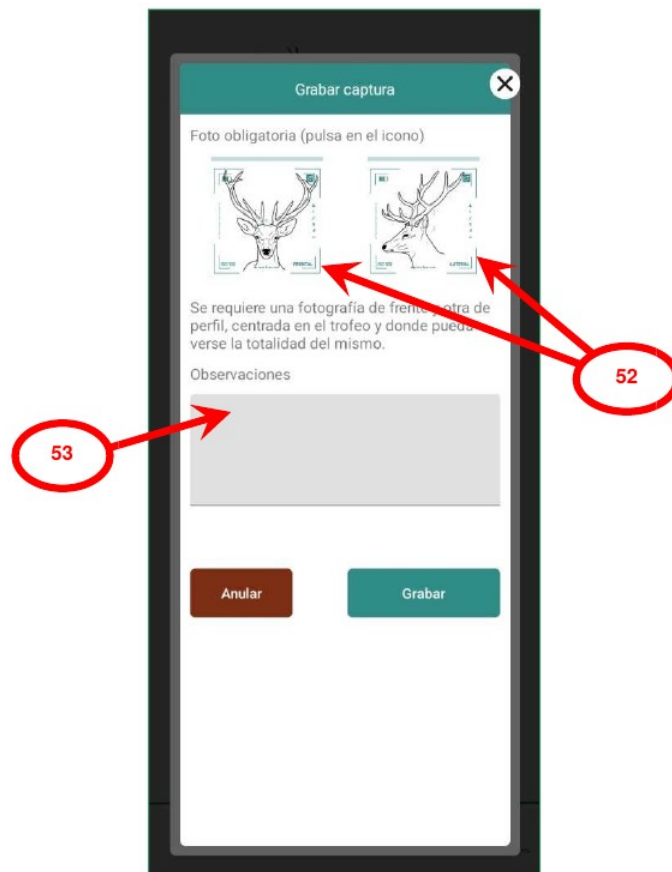
Callout 48: species selection (red deer / Ciervo).

3. Once the preserve is selected and the species chosen, the tags⁴⁹ linked to the authorization assigned to the hunter or organizer for that preserve and specific method are displayed automatically. Captures can be recorded within the open days enabled in the authorization; where the day is not an open day for the species, the text **Not available today** (*No disponible hoy*)⁵⁰ is shown, making recording impossible. The hunter must choose which of the activated tags to use by tapping the **Select** (*Seleccionar*) button⁵¹.



Callout 49: tags linked to the authorization. Callout 50: "Not available today". Callout 51: Select button.

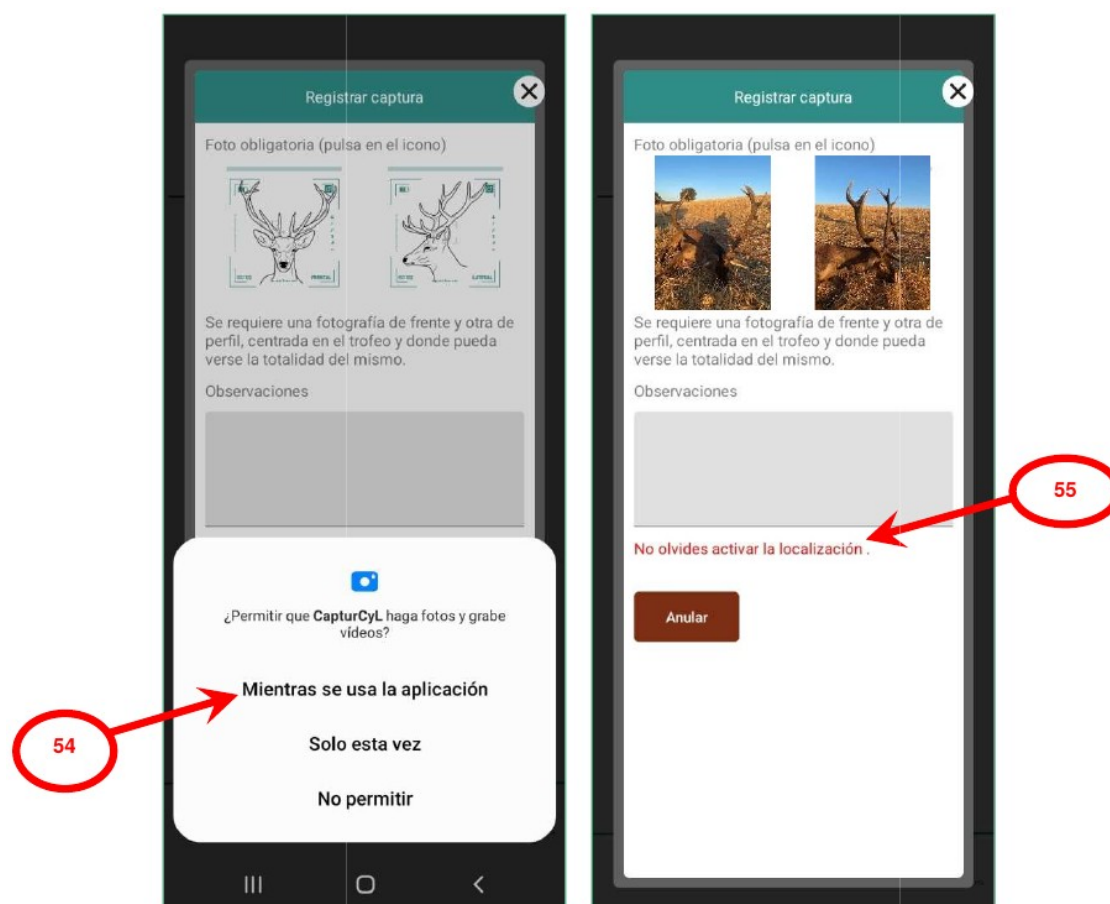
4. Once the tag is selected, a screen opens where the hunter or organizer must:
 - Mandatorily, take photographs of the capture⁵². For males of the roe deer, red deer, fallow deer, mouflon, Iberian ibex and chamois species, as well as for females of Iberian ibex and chamois, two photographs of the trophy are taken according to the specifications contained in the app. For females of the above species, except Iberian ibex and chamois, a single photograph of the whole animal is taken, from head to tail, showing the entire body.
 - Optionally, any incident or comment regarding aspects presumed relevant, such as the physical appearance or health condition of the animal, can be indicated in the **Observations** (*Observaciones*) section⁵³.



Record capture screen. Callout 52: mandatory photo icons with example framing. Callout 53: Observations field.

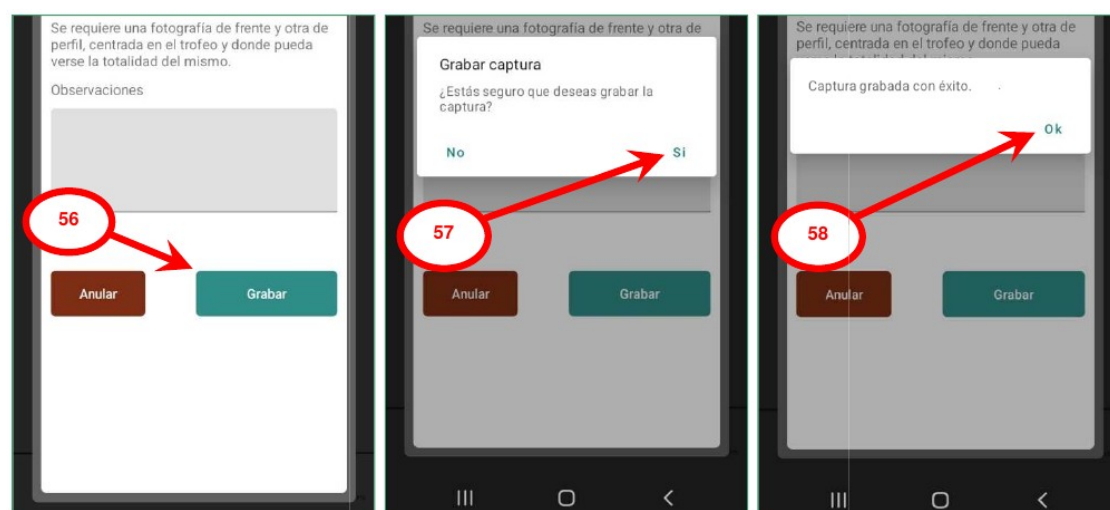
Important notices:

- To take the photographs, simply tap the icon in the app showing an example of the type of photograph required⁵². When this option is used for the first time, the application requests permission to access the device's camera; it is recommended to select the **While using the app** option⁵⁴.
- If the photographs are not taken, the capture cannot be recorded.
- It is mandatory to have location enabled on the phone; to that end, the application must first be granted permission to access the device's location. If permissions are disabled, the notice **Don't forget to enable location** (No olvides activar la localización)⁵⁵ appears.

- The last step to record the capture is to tap the **Record (Grabar)** button ⁵⁶; if everything is correct, confirmation is requested ⁵⁷ and, once accepted, the message **Capture recorded successfully (Captura grabada con éxito)** ⁵⁸ is returned.



Callouts 56 to 58: Record button, confirmation dialog and success message.

Important notices:

- Even if the hunter or organizer records the capture in an area without internet coverage, it is stored in the device's memory until coverage is available. In these cases, the information is sent whenever there is coverage and the app is open.

- The application geolocates the point only at the moment the hunter or organizer records the capture. Where there is no GPS coverage to record the capture, the application searches for coverage for a few seconds; after that short time, a countdown from 10 to 0 seconds starts, enabling the **Record** button⁵⁶.

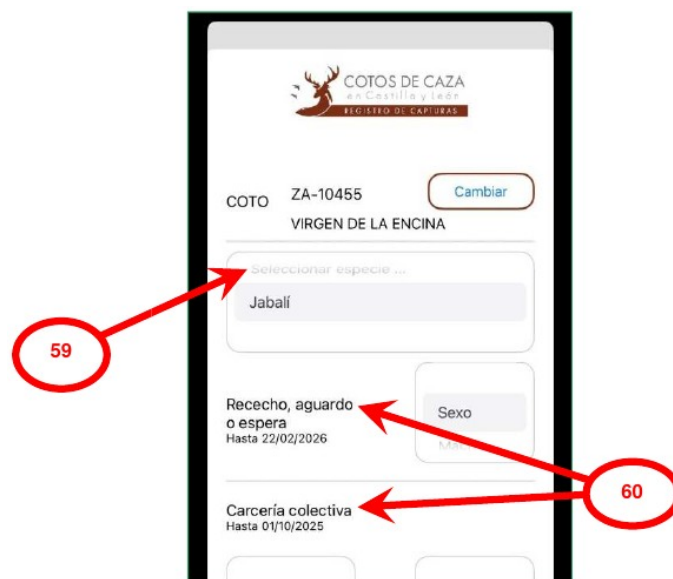
Recording wild boar captures:

The wild boar big game species has no pre-assigned unique traceability codes (tags); they are generated when the capture is recorded.

- In authorizations for hunters under the stalking, stand or wait, walked-up and driven-in-line methods, the capture must be recorded without moving the animal or separating the trophy from the rest of the animal.
- In authorizations for organizers of collective hunts under the montería and gancho formats, the capture or captures must be recorded once the hunt is over, before moving the animals out of the preserve where they were captured or away from the game collection point.

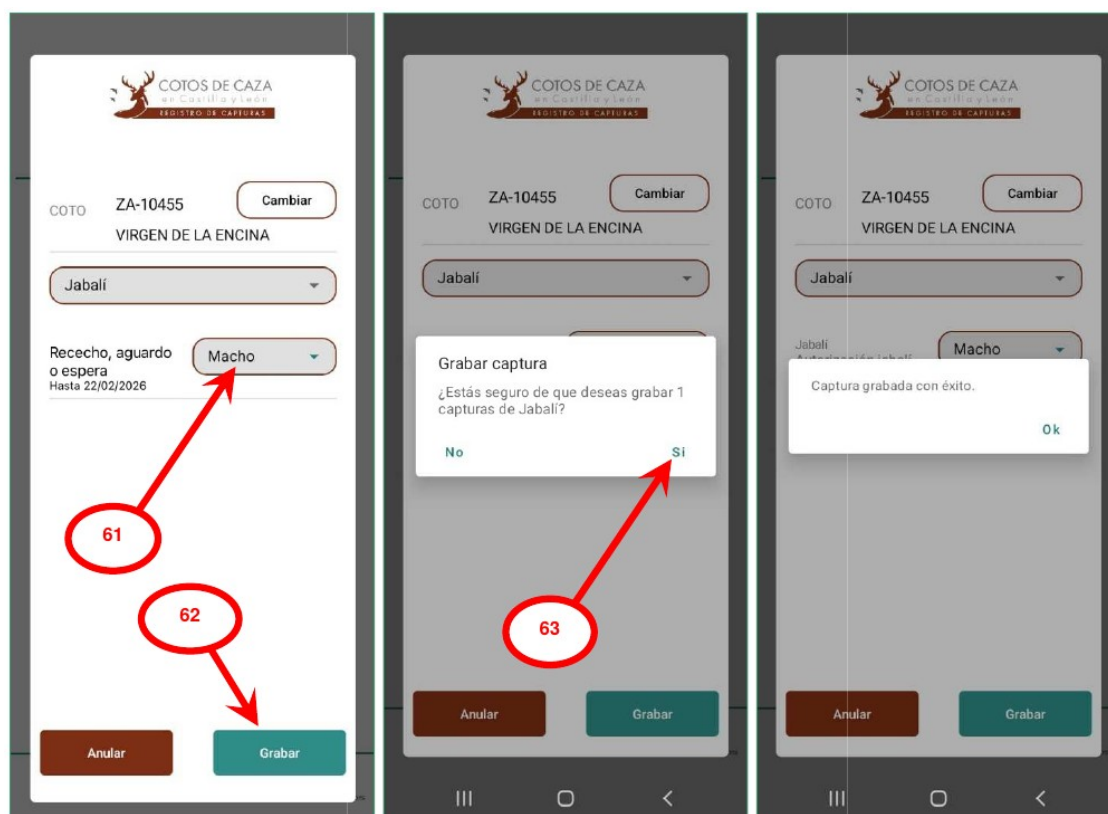
The steps for recording captures are similar to those for the other big game species, with the following particularities:

1. When using **Select**⁵⁹ for the species, the authorization to which the capture corresponds must be chosen⁶⁰.



Callout 59: wild boar selected. Callout 60: choice of authorization (stalking/stand or collective hunt).

2. For authorizations issued to hunters under the stalking, stand or wait, walked-up and driven-in-line methods, once the sex is selected⁶¹, the capture can be recorded via **Record**⁶² and must then be confirmed⁶³.

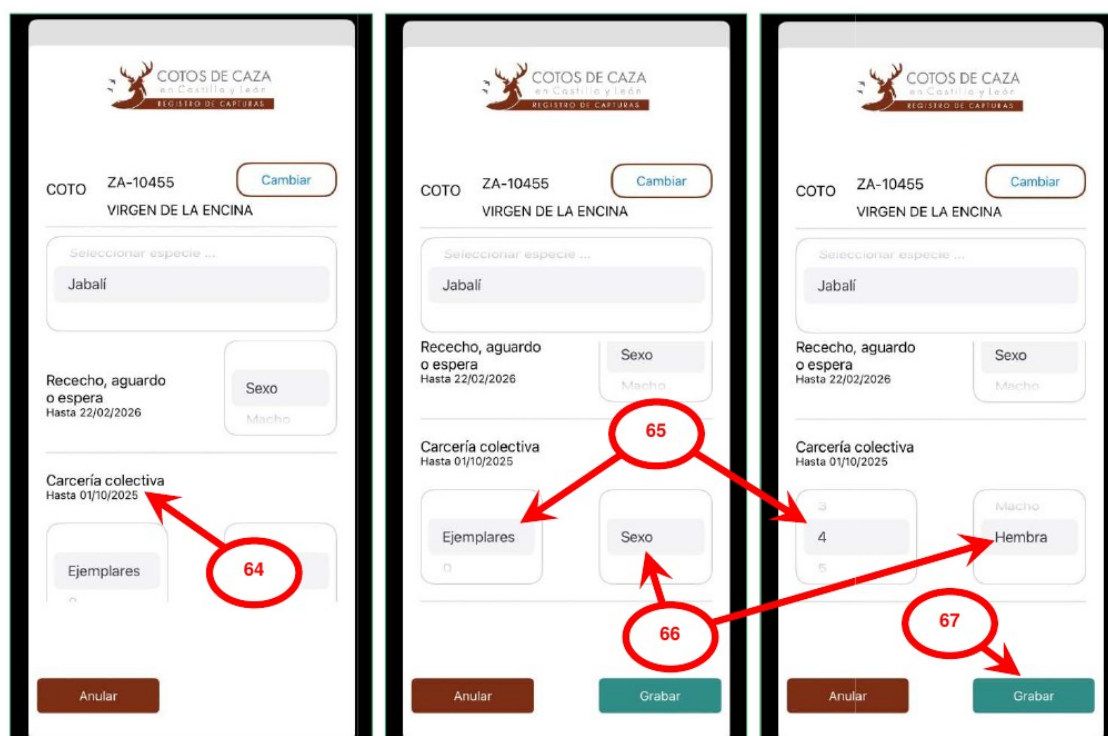


Callouts 61 to 63: sex selection, Record button, confirmation and success message.

Important notice:

- Under the stalking, stand or wait, walked-up and driven-in-line methods, the hunter can only record one wild boar specimen per recording action.

- For authorizations issued to organizers under the montería and gancho formats, the capture record must include the total number of specimens of each sex hunted during the hunt. To do so, first select the authorization ⁶⁴ to which the captures will be linked, then indicate the number of specimens hunted in the **Specimens** (*Ejemplares*) field ⁶⁵ and the **Sex** (*Sexo*) ⁶⁶; once these fields are completed, proceed to **Record** ⁶⁷ the captures, which must then be confirmed. The number of specimens of the opposite sex is recorded in the same way.



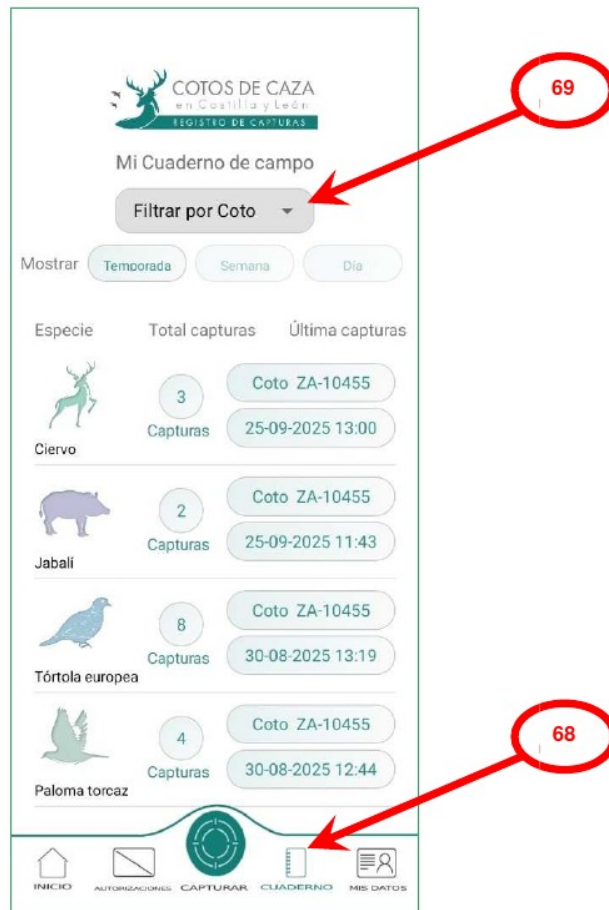
Callouts 64 to 67: authorization selection, Specimens and Sex fields, Record button.

Important notices:

- Under the montería and gancho formats, the organizer must record separately the total number of male and female wild boar specimens; even where no captures of one sex occurred, zero must be indicated.
- Under the montería and gancho formats, only the organizer records the captures. No hunter attending the montería or gancho has to record any capture.
- For the wild boar species, no photograph of the animal is required.
- Even if the hunter or organizer records the capture in an area without internet coverage, it is stored in the device's memory until coverage is available. In these cases, the information is sent whenever there is coverage and the app is open.
- The application geolocates the point only at the moment the hunter or organizer records the capture. Where there is no GPS coverage to record the capture, the application searches for coverage for a few seconds; after that short time, a countdown from 10 to 0 seconds starts, enabling the **Record** button.

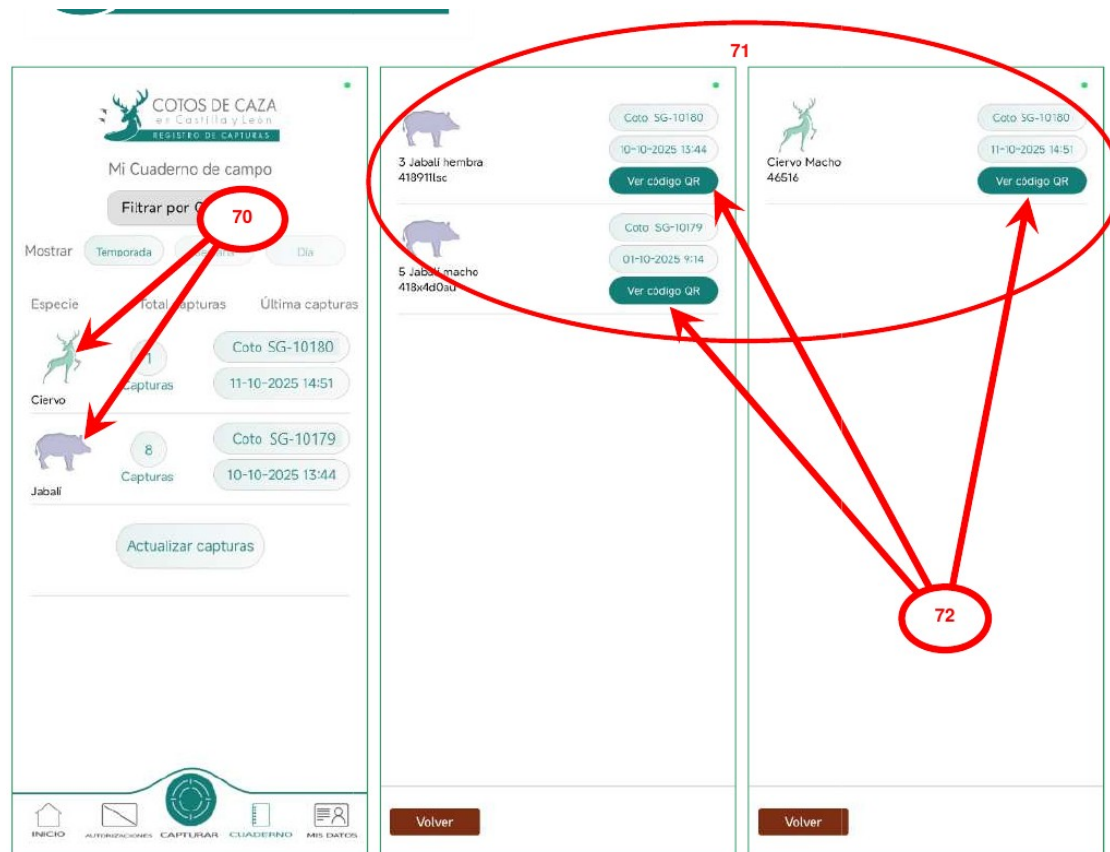
3.4 LOGBOOK tab (CUADERNO)

Once the recording of a capture by the hunter or organizer is completed, the application automatically takes them to the **LOGBOOK** tab ⁶⁸, where the hunter or organizer has all the information relating to their captures. This tab has a filter to display captures by hunting preserve ⁶⁹.

Recorded captures are grouped by species; to access each capture of a species individually, tap the species icon⁷⁰. A new screen then shows the basic information of the captures⁷¹: number (the number only appears for wild boar captures recorded under the montería or gancho format), species and sex, unique traceability code, hunting preserve registration number, and date and time of recording.



Callout 70: species icons. Callout 71: capture details. Callout 72: View QR code buttons.

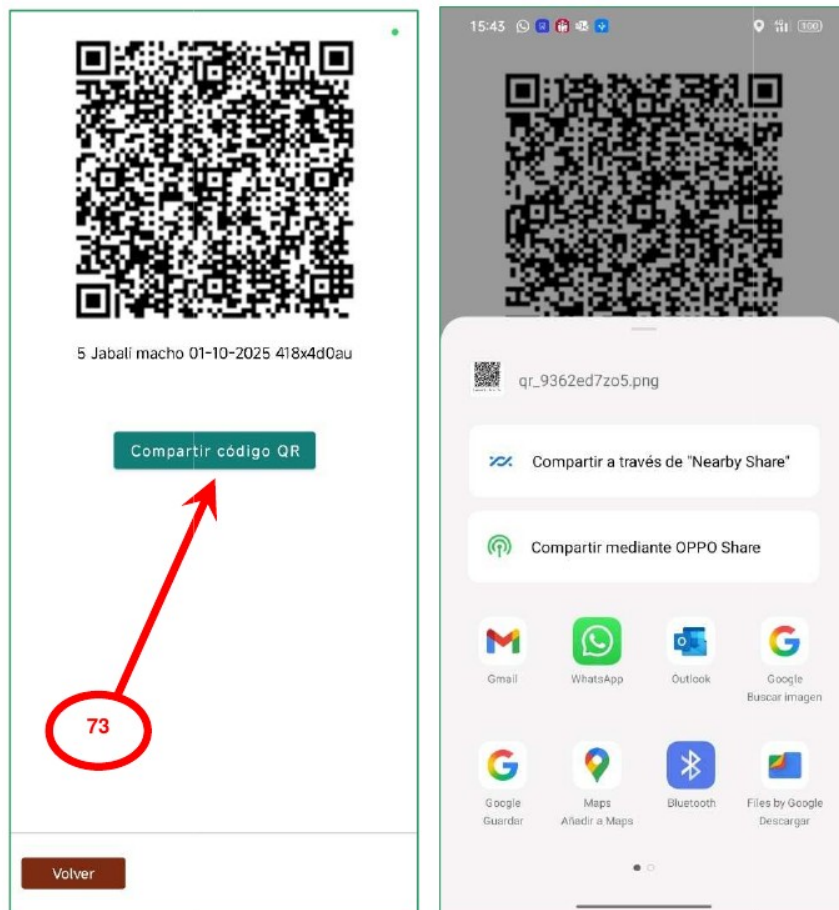
With each capture recording, the application generates a QR code accessible through the **View QR code** (Ver código QR) button⁷².

The generated QR code acts as a digital tag storing the following data:

- For the red deer, roe deer, Iberian ibex, chamois, fallow deer and mouflon species: pre-assigned unique traceability code, species and sex, hunting preserve, date and time of recording, name and NIF of the hunter/organizer, recording coordinates and photographs.
- For the wild boar species: generated unique traceability code, number, species and sex, hunting preserve, date and time of recording, name and NIF of the hunter or organizer, and recording coordinates.

This QR code can be downloaded and used as a traceability document for the transport of the game animals, the trophy or their parts, by the hunter or by third parties. This code can only be consulted by law enforcement officers registered in the capture control system linked to CAPTURCYL.

One of the features offered by the CAPTURCYL app is the possibility for the hunter or organizer, through the **Share QR code** (Compartir código QR) button⁷³, to export the code to other devices via WhatsApp, e-mail, etc.



Callout 73: Share QR code button and the device's sharing options.

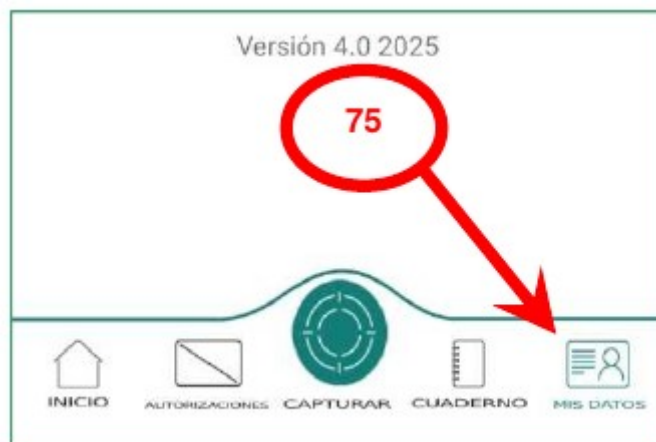
Each time the user logs out, the captures cease to be available in the **LOGBOOK** tab; they can be downloaded again at any time by tapping the **Refresh captures** (*Actualizar capturas*) button⁷⁴. This avoids massive data storage in the device's cache.

3.5 MY DETAILS tab (MIS DATOS)

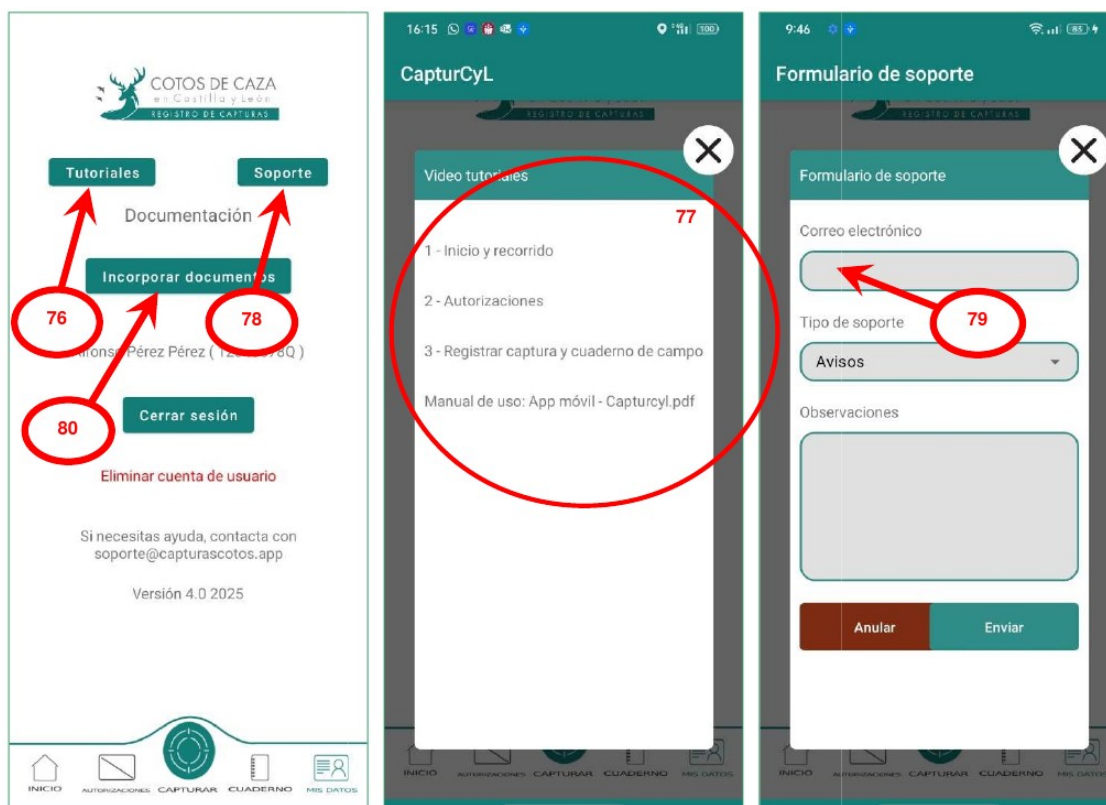
The **MY DETAILS** tab⁷⁵ is a simple screen containing a series of sub-tabs (**Tutorials**, **Support**, **Upload documents** and **Log out**) whose functionalities are described below.

3.5.1 Tutorials sub-tab (Tutoriales)

The **Tutorials** sub-tab⁷⁶ makes available to the hunter or organizer a series of video tutorials and this CAPTURCYL user manual in PDF format⁷⁷.

3.5.2 Support sub-tab (Soporte)

Through the **Support** sub-tab⁷⁸, the user accesses a form for reporting to the CAPTURCYL administrator questions relating to **Notices**, **My preserves**, **Authorizations**, **Captures**, **Logbook**, **My details** and

Other, for which an **E-mail address**⁷⁹ must be indicated, to which the answers to the questions raised will be sent.

3.5.3 Upload documents sub-tab (Incorporar documentos)

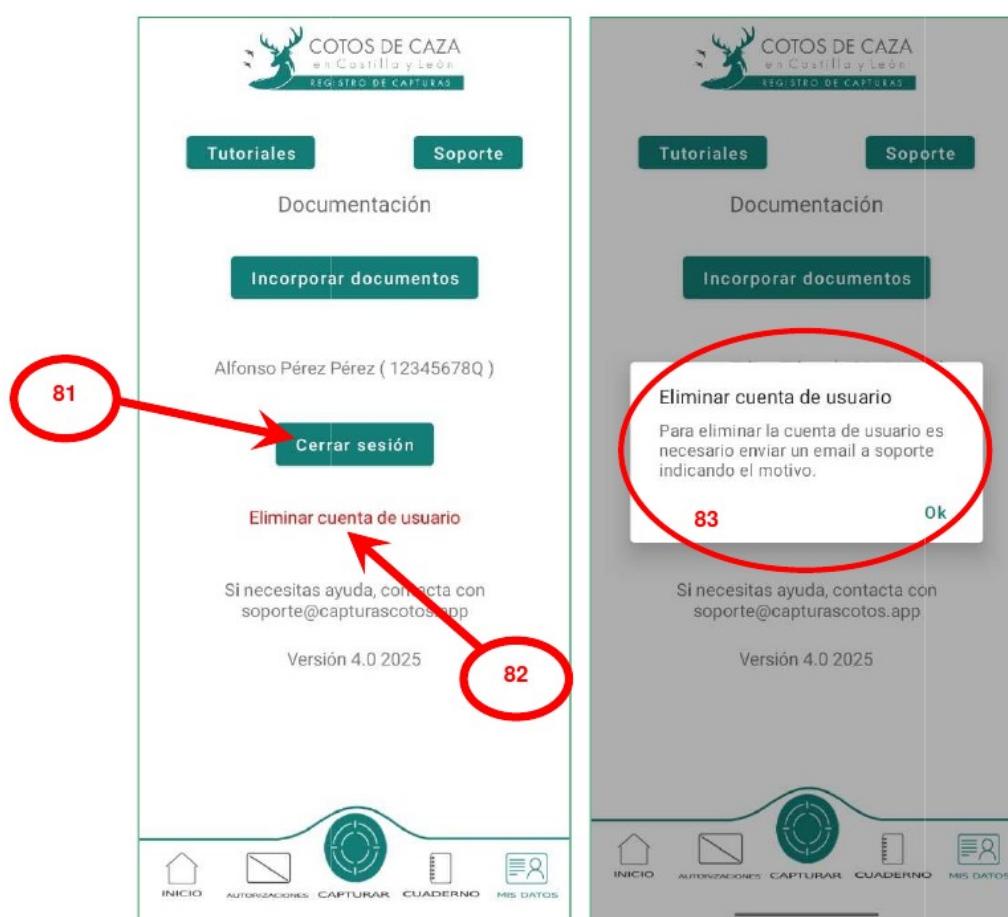
The **Upload documents** sub-tab⁸⁰ allows the hunter or organizer to upload to the app any documents in PDF or image format they consider appropriate (hunting license, hunter's insurance, etc.).

3.5.4 Log out sub-tab (Cerrar sesión)

The **Log out** sub-tab⁸¹ allows the hunter or organizer to end their session, thereby finishing their use of the app.

3.5.5 Delete user account sub-tab (Eliminar cuenta de usuario)

The **Delete user account** sub-tab⁸² allows the user to delete their app account. In any case, if the hunter or organizer decides to delete their user account, a pop-up window⁸³ informs them of the steps to follow.
